Update on Water Main Break, Boil Alert Remain in Effect

Birmingham, AL – Birmingham Water Works (BWW) is pleased to announce that the broken valve discovered during the leak repair process has been replaced. We are nearing the completion of the water restoration process; however, some customers may experience low water pressure. Please be reminded that a Boil Water Alert remains in effect until further notice for all residents in the impacted service area.

Residents are urged to use boiled or bottled water for the following purposes:

- Drinking
- Making ice
- Brushing teeth
- Washing dishes
- Preparing food



Safety Precautions:

- Water should be brought to a rolling boil for at least 3 minutes and allowed to cool before use.
- Do not use ice from ice trays, automatic ice dispensers, or ice makers affected by tap water.
- Discard all ice made from tap water during the boil alert period.
- Prepare baby formula with boiled or bottled water only.
- Opt for disposable cups, plates, and utensils to ensure safety.

Areas Under Boil Alert:

 Forestdale, Sandusky, Pratt City, Lewisburg, Upper Coalburg, Coalburg, Mineral Springs, Pinkney City, Hayes Highland, Greenleas Heights, Smithfield Estates, Zion Heights, Westwood, Union Grove, Hillview, Adamsville, Fultondale, along US Highway 78, Cherry Avenue, Tomahawk Drive, and streets adjacent to Pratt Highway, Dugan Highway, Hibernian Street, Coalburg Road, Upper Coalburg Road, Heflin Avenue, Walker Chapel Road, and Brookside Coalburg Road.

Birmingham Water Works (BWW) continues water distribution for customers affected by the boil alert in Northwest Jefferson County. Below are the updated details for water distribution:
