BIRMINGHAM WATER WORKS HELPS FANS BEAT THE HEAT AT THE WORLD GAMES 2022

Utility Encourages Fans to Stay Hydrated & Stay Healthy with Misting Stations at Nine

Venues

BIRMINGHAM, ALABAMA (JULY 7, 2022) — Organizers of The World Games 2022 anticipate hundreds of thousands of spectators to converge upon the Birmingham metropolitan area July 7-17, with average high temperatures expected to be 93°F over the course of the event.

To beat the heat, Birmingham Water Works has several activities planned to help fans stay cool and healthy during the peak of summertime temperatures.

Birmingham Water Works will host misting and educational stations at eight venues, including a super-sized inflatable misting station at the University of Alabama at Birmingham's PNC Field for men's and women's field lacrosse competitions. In addition to cooling off, fans can pick up promotional items and educational materials or play fun water-based games for all ages.

"Water is an important resource not only for maintaining hydration but also for helping to keep cool," says Rick Jackson, Birmingham Water Works Public Relations Manager & Spokesperson. "We pride ourselves on delivering high-quality drinking water and reliable

service to our customers, and our role during The World Games will center on education and helping people cool off."

Birmingham Water Works is also lending one of its inflatable misting stations to Faith Chapel Care Center for use at its cooling shelter downtown Birmingham.

The international sporting event will draw 3,600 world-class athletes from more than 100 countries to compete for gold in 34 emerging sports. The games will occur at 15 indoor and outdoor venues across the Birmingham metropolitan area.
